Materials Needed

Purpose and Learning Objectives of Program

This year's training focuses on how everyone at HCA can stay on the path to demonstrating greater respect and inclusion through increased knowledge and awareness of HCA policies. Four topics consisting of ADA compliance, HIPAA privacy, Political views and Substance use are depicted in video vignettes showing real world situations. At the end of the program, you will have a greater awareness of:

- How policies on ADA, HIPAA Privacy, Substance Use and Political Views are consistent with and grounded in our values of treating others with respect and preserving dignity.
- The ways in which demonstrating respect and inclusion helps us all to do our jobs more effectively and productively.
- How following HCA policies can help to ensure patient safety and employee safety.
- The specific policies and procedures presented in this training and how they reinforce our Code of Conduct.

Before you Get Started

Before inserting the CD into the drive:

- 1. Make sure you have 1 hour in order to complete the training;
- 2. Make sure the volume is up fairly high on your computer; and
- 3. Close all other applications.

When the CD is placed in the CD-ROM drive, it will begin automatically. You will see prompts asking you to sign in. Type your first and last name only; the date will automatically be entered.

This CD is a self-contained, interactive training program. Follow the navigation instructions provided to make your way through the course.

Note: If it is necessary for you to exit the training before you have completely viewed each section, the CD will NOT bookmark where you stopped. It is very important to only start the training when you have an hour to commit to the training, otherwise you will have to begin again.

After you complete the course, you will have access to the Certificate of Completion.
